Making a sales complaint

The aim of this process is to resolve all customer issues or concerns as quickly as possible. In the majority of cases issues can be resolved quickly and amicably to customers' satisfaction by our branch colleagues.

Stage One – Silas Rains - Director

Complaints should, in the first instance, be directed to Silas Rains – Director. They will acknowledge your complaint in writing, within 3 working days, in line with this procedure and then endeavour to liaise with you to resolve your complaint immediately but no later than 15 working days from our letter of acknowledgement.

Stage Two – Silas Rains - Director

If, after you have dealt with the Director you remain dissatisfied, you can request a review of your complaint, in writing, from Silas Rains. Once received your complaint will be reviewed and we will send you a final viewpoint response in writing within 15 working days from receipt of your request for a review. If longer is required you will be notified in writing with an explanation and indication of the timescale.

Stage One – Silas Rains - Director

Complaints should, in the first instance, be directed to Silas Rains – Director. They will acknowledge your complaint in writing within 3 working days (excluding weekends and public holidays) of receipt, in line with this procedure and then endeavour to liaise with you to resolve your complaint as quickly as possible, but no later than 15 working days from our letter of acknowledgement.

Stage Two - Silas Rains - Director

If, after your response from the Director, you remain dissatisfied, you may address your concerns, in writing, to Silas Rains. Once received your letter will be acknowledged within 3 working days, (excluding weekends and public holidays), and you will receive a response within 15 working days from receipt of your letter. If a longer timeframe is required you will be notified in writing with an explanation and indication of timescale.
